

COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

August 25, 2020

The Town of Didsbury Council held the Regular Council Meeting on Tuesday, August 25, 2020 using Zoom Meeting. Seven (7) members of the public participated in the meeting.

- Council granted first reading to Bylaw 2020-12, a bylaw to establish Procedures for Council and Committees meetings. This bylaw and Bylaw 2020-11 (Council Committees) will be go to a future Committee Meeting for review.
- Council will review projects to be funded through the Municipal Stimulus Program at the Council Committee Meeting on September 8, 2020 at 4:30 p.m. conducting using ZOOM Meetings.
- Mayor Hunter presented Paton Rothenbush with the Town of Didsbury High School Scholarship award.
- Council approved to be a Gold Sponsor for the Mountain View Seniors' Housing Foundation annual golf tournament on September 17, 2020 at the Olds Golf Club. Mayor Hunter will also be putting together a team of four (4) to participate in the event.
- Council approved a reconfiguration design for Council Chambers and safety measures that would allow Council members to return to in-person meetings beginning this fall. The design will allow for approximately 15 members of the public to attend.
- Council approved for the Didsbury High School to have a Grad Parade made up of approximately 55 vehicles on Saturday, August 29th starting at 3:30 p.m. The parade will start at the Zion Church and end at the High School.
- Council approved for the Town of Didsbury to participate in the "AUMA Showcase Your Municipality" at the 2020 Convention in September. The Town is calling for photos of front-line workers in the community. The chosen photo will be included in a video project made up of front-line workers across Alberta. The Town is also seeking submissions from businesses of their made-in Alberta product(s), and will be presented at the AUMA Convention on September 24th. Submission deadline is on or before September 4th at 4:00 p.m. attention to Phil Boucher, Economic Development Officer, Town of Didsbury.
