

COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

June 9, 2020

The Town of Didsbury Council held a Regular Council Meeting on Tuesday, June 9, 2020 using Zoom Meeting. Five (5) members of the public participated in the meeting.

Council granted a \$250 grant to the Didsbury Golf Club for sponsorship of the flower garden at Hole #1.

Council approved to send a letter to the Honourable Nathan Cooper, MLA for Olds-Didsbury-Three Hills along with other provincial officials requesting the Alberta Government increase the funding to the Film and Television Tax Credit Program. Filming in Alberta is on the rise and with more support; this will be another way for Alberta to diversity the economy.

Council asked Administration to develop a basic plan and associated budget implications for Christmas Lights/Decorations for the Town.

The Town of Didsbury is getting requests for Food Truck Vendors to be located at various locations. Council asked Administration to bring back a policy framework to address fees, rules and regulations and permits.

With the phase two relaunch on June 12, 2020 announced by the Provincial Government, Council approved the opening of the Town of Didsbury parks and sports fields and recreation grounds for group use.

Council approved a Joint Statement from the Didsbury Library and the Town of Didsbury regarding the new library project. The statement will be released the week of June 15th.
