



COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

February 28, 2023

The Town of Didsbury Council held a Regular Council Meeting on Tuesday, February 28, 2023, in Council Chambers, 1606 – 14 Street.

- The Zion Youth Group attended the Council meeting to present a proposed design of the Mural for the basketball court located on 20 Avenue. The design was approved.
- There was a high attendance at the Council meeting and Council held two Public Hearings—one for Shantz Village and one amending the Land Use Bylaw to add the use for “Market” in the C3 Core zoning. Following the Public Hearing, Council granted second and third reading to all three bylaws presented.
- The Community Services Board (CSB) met on January 3, 2023 to review the 2023 Family and Community Support Services (FCSS) funding applications and to make recommendations to Council for allocation of these funds. In 2023, \$64,000 is budgeted for the 2023 Community Grants, and 13 applications were received, with a total request value of \$156,587.19. Council approved the 2023 FCSS grant funding as presented, valued at \$64,000.
- Council also approved the rebranding for the Didsbury Family and Community Support Services logo.
