

COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

February 22, 2022

The Town of Didsbury Council held the Regular Council Meeting on Tuesday February 22, 2022, in Council Chambers, 1606 - 14 Street.

- Staff Sgt. Browne presented the 3rd Quarter Didsbury RCMP Detachment Report.
- Town of Didsbury Municipal Enforcement Community Peace Officers gave an overview on the 2021 Year End Report outlining their priorities for 2022.
- Following the Public Hearing, Council gave 2nd and 3rd reading of Bylaw 2022-01 Amendment to the Land Use Bylaw to create a Commercial Core District.
- Council gave approval to proceed with the application for the Alberta Municipal Water/Wastewater Partnership Funding Grant for the East Didsbury Water Reservoir.
- Council supported a letter written by the Municipal Area Partnership expressing concerns related to challenges to Olds College created by the Reform of Agencies, Boards, and Commissions Compensation Act.
- Council questioned the 2021 Federal Census results that were published as a decrease of population by 198 and asked Administration to bring back information on the impacts to grant funding to our municipality.
- The CAO Report identified that the 2022 assessment in our municipality has increased by \$55,466,750, a 10% change over 2021.
- The 4th Quarter Financial Report was presented outlining the healthy status of the 2021 Capital Budget Schedule, the Reserve Continuity Schedule, and the Capital Grants Continuity Schedule.
