



COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

The Town of Didsbury Council held a Regular Council Meeting on Tuesday, October 10, 2023, in Council Chambers at 1606 – 14 Street.

- The Asset Management Strategy serves to optimize the utilization and management of a wide range of Town-owned assets including playgrounds, roads, water lines, and fire trucks. This plan outlines the goals for Asset Management which will guide the priorities for assessment, maintenance, and replacement of assets for the next five years and onwards. - The Engineering and Infrastructure department has been working to reduce the amount of unmetered water that is lost through the network. As a result of two critical leak repairs and one emergency repair this year, the department is pleased to report that one of the key performance indicators suggests that unmetered water loss is at a three year low.
- Council granted second reading to the Heavy Vehicle Truck Bylaw 2022-11 with a new “Schedule B” which includes a map of the Heavy Vehicle Truck Route. The bylaw will now be reviewed by the Policy and Governance Committee which will then bring back recommendations to Council regarding a number of considerations including signage, consultation with partners, potential educational initiatives, and enforcement.
- Council approved a \$1,390 expenditure from the 2024 Budget for two members of the Didsbury Economic Development Advisory Committee to attend the 2024 EDA Experience Leaders’ Summit & Conference to be held in Kananaskis in 2024.
