



# COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

January 11, 2022

The Town of Didsbury Council held the Regular Council Meeting on Tuesday January 11, 2022 via ZOOM Meetings.

- Council was presented with the final draft of the Regional Recreation & Culture Master Plan from Expedition Consulting Management
- Council was given a presentation from Alberta Regional Rail Inc. looking for support for a Regional Railway System between Calgary and Edmonton.
- Council was pleased to appoint a new member to the Didsbury Economic Advisory Committee
- The 2022 Capital budget was passed in the amount of \$2,808.500, all funded from reserves, grants, and external grants.
- Council deferred the three projects (cemetery pathway, columbarium purchase and 23<sup>rd</sup> Street North upgrades) that included 2022 Operating Budget funding to the Operating Budget workshop.
- Council directed Administration to arrange a meeting for Council to discuss common interests with the Didsbury Municipal Library Board.
- Council extended gratitude and appreciation to all of the community volunteers and donors who contributed to the sparkle and shine of the Rosebud Valley Campground Winter Wonderland.
- Council was presented with information in the CAO Report about the newly implemented and clearly defined Fleet Management Program Matrix and Process.
